**Description:** An overview of door systems typically designed, specified, and installed in hospitals; with a primary focus on the most common applications with automatic swinging doors and Intensive Care Unit/Critical Care Unit (ICU/CCU) manual sliding doors.

**Learning Objectives:** By the end of the program the attendee should have a basic understanding of: the requirements for swinging automatic door systems in a hospital environment; including, activation, safety, coordination, and layout; the various designs for ICU/CCU entrances and how selected configurations impact functionality; code requirements for safety, accessibility, and egress.

**How Taught:** The CES facilitator utilizes a PowerPoint presentation to provide an in-depth overview of the function, layout, and safety requirements for automatic swinging doors and ICU/CCU manual sliding doors.

**A/V Needed:** Electrical power and a screen for the presentation. The CES facilitator

will provide the necessary laptop computer and will coordinate with the on-site professional development administrator to make provisions for projection equipment.

**Target Audience:** Architects, Engineers, specifiers, owners, and other design professionals serving the hospital market. The recommended audience size is between 5 and 50 professionals. The program is suitable for professionals of varying experience level and includes a question and answer period at the end of the program.

**Facilitator Qualifications:** All Stanley Access Technologies Regional Managers have been trained on CES guidelines and presentation skills. Additionally, they are certified by the American Association of Automatic Door Manufacturers (AAADM) as experts in the application and safety of presented door systems.
